To Whom It May Concern,

Peter Wolf presented to my office on 3-7-25 for injuries sustained from an accident. He stated that he injured his right shoulder as a result of having to abruptly swerve his vehicle to avoid a traffic hazard.

He was diagnosed with a strain to the right shoulder and somatic dysfunction to his cervical and thoracic spine which can take time to manifest after the initial injury due to the increasing inflammation. He received mild manipulation from Dr. Robotham (an associate at my office) and also with physical therapy to reduce inflammation, pain, and muscle spasms. For continued home care, he was told to ice 15 minutes every hour to further reduce inflammation.

In communicating with him on 3-10-25, he mentioned that he is 98% improved from his initial treatment on 3-7-25. With this in mind, he may need 1 additional visit to return him to his pre-injury status.
